Events are open to anyone, not only CUNY students. Languages spoken: English, Spanish and Chinese. Experienced lawyers and other immigration professionals will assist you in filling out forms if you meet all the following naturalization requirements:

- You have resided in the United States as a permanent resident for 5 years (or 3 years if you are married to and living with a U.S. citizen)
- You have been physically present in the United States for half of the 5 years (or 3-year period)
- You are at least 18 years old

A \$680 filing fee (check or money order) is required by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services.
