

FAQ: Nursing, undergraduate (generics)

1. **Must be a Lehman College Student**
 2. **All application to the Nursing Program must be in by March 15th**
 3. **HESI pre-admission exam must be taken (subjects: reading comprehension, mathematics, Anatomy and Physiology and Critical thinking; Score of 75% or better in each except for critical thinking, a raw score of 800 or higher required for critical thinking)**
 4. **Minimum GPA of 2.75 in the sciences**
 5. **Only the first grade given for a course is counted**
 6. **HIN 268 with a grade of C or better**
 7. **MUST get permission from the Department of Nursing to Register for HIN, NUR courses**
- Registration for HESI November thru December
 - HESI Exam given once per year: January – February: ([Testing and advisement page](#))
 - Deadline to turn in application, March 15th ([Application](#))
 - Accelerated Program: **Must have a Bachelor or higher degree**; course requirements same as generics
 - Walk –in-advisement days posted on web page: ([Testing and advisement page](#))
 - Admission to Nursing Program only in the Fall
 - Admission to the Nursing Program is separate from being admitted to Lehman College
 - Must be admitted to Lehman College before applying to Lehman Nursing Program
 - Generic program: 2 years
 - Accelerated program: 12 months
 - Pre Nursing Required courses: CHE 114, 115, 120, 121, BIO 181, 182, 230,
