## Modern Facilities in a Traditional Setting . . .



Situated in a residential community in the northwest Bronx, the tree-lined, 37-acre Lehman campus is one of the most beautiful in the tri-state area. It blends picturesque buildings more than half a century old with state-of-the-art facilities that include:

- The Information Technology Center, opened in 1999, houses eight micro-computer classrooms; a classroom with high-end graphics workstations; an open lab area for research, practice and homework with over 100 microcomputers; Internet access, printing facilities and a help desk. Terminals are linked to The City University of New York's University Computer Center, one of the largest, most sophisticated university computer facilities in the world. The IT Center supports video distribution and has satellite uplink and downlink capabilities.
- The Lehman College Library, housed in a modern, four-story building, has an online book catalogue and circulation system, a CD-ROM LAN and access to networked periodical indexes and full-text databases. The open stacks book collection of over 546,000 volumes is supplemented by more than 1,300 periodicals and 574,000 microfilms.
- The APEX, a state-of-the-art athletic and physical education facility, features an eight-lane Olympic-size pool, ballet studio, aerobics studio, two gymnasiums, racquetball courts, running track, weight room and cardiovascular fitness center. The College also has outdoor tennis courts and soccer, softball and baseball fields.
- The Lehman Center for the Performing Arts with its 2,300-seat Concert Hall presents outstanding international classical, popular and folk/ethnic dance, music and theatre companies as well as emerging local performers. Special programs are offered for Bronx school children and senior citizens.
- The 500-seat Lovinger Theatre presents performances in theatre, dance and music by Lehman College students, faculty and guest artists.
- The ultramodern Fine Arts Building houses the Art Department's studios, workshops, computer labs and classrooms. The Lehman College Art Gallery features two striking exhibition spaces on the first floor of this building. Leading figures in contemporary art, emerging artists and theme shows are presented by the Gallery.
