Graphics, Web Design and Desktop Publishing Courses

Computer Graphics Using Photoshop EDP 56/\$305

This introductory level course is intended to provide students with an overview of computer graphics on Windows-based systems. Students learn to scan existing images and to create and edit images with Adobe Photoshop 6 for Windows. Other topics include graphic file formats, file conversion and compression and the basic principles of good graphic design. Computer hardware and system resource issues are discussed. (Prerequisite: EDP 07 Introduction to Microcomputing or equivalent course or experience)

Publishing on the World Wide Web EDP 115/\$305

Students are introduced to HTML (HyperText Markup Language), the language used to create documents or "pages" for publication on the World Wide Web. Students learn to design and format documents, embed links to other resources; and use lists, tables, forms and frames. How to incorporate and manage graphic content created in other programs such as Photoshop and obtained from input devices such as scanners is covered. Emphasis is placed on creating effective, informative and aesthetically-pleasing Web content. (Prerequisite: EDP 07 Introduction to Microcomputing or equivalent course or experience)

New! Adobe Illustrator EDP 64/\$305

Adobe Illustrator is the industry-standard object-oriented graphics application used to create drawings, logos, typographic designs, charts, maps, artwork and other materials for print and electronic publications. Topics include Illustrator tools for creating, selecting, copying, transforming, and reshaping drawings and other vector graphics; layers, masks and filters; working with type; and the management of output (Prerequisite: **EDP 07** *Introduction to Microcomputing* or equivalent course or experience.)

Mondays, Feb. 24 – May 5, 6:30-9 pm, 10 sessions

Quark XPress EDP 67/\$305

Students learn the basics of document creation while preparing flyers, newsletters, brochures and advertisements. Topics include typography, manipulating and importing text and graphics, special effects, preparation of documents for production, graphical design elements such as borders and the use of color. Emphasis is on the basic principles of effective composition and organization of text and image on the printed page. (Prerequisite: **EDP 07** *Introduction to Microcomputing* or the equivalent course or experience.)
