\*Files in the Collection are all full text and arranged by box (b) and file (f) number.

- **EXAMPLE #1: box and file number**  
b17- f2 in the citation below indicates where the citation is found.

**b17 – f2** – Tusiani, Joseph. *Creation of the World by Torquato Tasso: annotated by Gaetano Cipolla*, Center for Medieval and Early Renaissance Studies, Binghamton, NY, 1982.

- **EXAMPLE #2: book in Leonard Lief Library**  
Leonard Lief Library Stack (STACK) PQ4225 .E5 T9 indicates an extra circulating copy.

- **EXAMPLE #3: hyperlinks (book and journal articles)**

The hyperlink <https://cuny-le.primo...> means this is a full text copy, When clicked, by members of the Lehman community (faculty, students, etc.) it will show “Available online” to indicate the database where the book can be read online. Once opened, click either PDF Full Text or Full Download.
