
### **Prioritization Quintiles**

- Quintile 4: <u>Needs Improvement</u> the program is in need of an improvement action plan to achieve current expectations.
- Quintile 5: <u>Needs substantial change</u> the program is in need of attention and requires substantial change in the form of reinvention, restructuring, or phase out.
