



## Master of Health Services Administration

The Master of Science in Health Services Administration is designed for students to excel in management positions within hospital systems, community-based clinics, non-profit organizations, private healthcare practices, and federal, state, and local government health surveillance and funding agencies. Students will learn to foster organizational health and well-being, improve health outcomes for patients, and enhance community resources.

### Admissions Requirements

- Official transcripts for all post-secondary institutions attended
- Bachelor's degree or its foreign equivalent from an accredited school
- Minimum undergraduate grade point average of 3.0
- Three letters recommendation: letters must be from an employer, healthcare professional or previous academic professor.
- A 500-word essay answering the prompts available in the application
- Current professional resume and cover letter detailing all past professional employment and any community or professional organization leadership positions, memberships, and service
- A performance evaluation
- An interview with faculty
- A minimum of one-year experience in a healthcare setting either as a healthcare clinician, administrator, or can demonstrate experience within business sectors for candidate who are early careerists:
  - Current Lehman College students with 60 credits and GPA of 3.0 are eligible to apply and their admission to the program is contingent upon successful completion of the HSA major
  - Healthcare executives and executive management-level professionals are eligible to apply with a minimum of 1 year of experience.
