



Master of Science in Education in Literacy Education Dual Certification: Literacy & Special Education (All Grades)

The Literacy and Special Education leads to a Master of Science in Education degree, initial certification in Special Education (All Grades), and professional certification in Literacy Education (All Grades). The program provides a bridge between communities, families, and schools. Teachers develop a combined mastery of research, theory, and instructional practices, and articulate working visions of the future of literacy and special education. The program prepares practitioners to work with students with special needs in a culturally diverse educational system.

Admissions Requirements

- Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended
- Bachelor's degree or foreign equivalent from an accredited school
- Minimum undergraduate gpa of 3.0, in exceptional cases, student with a gpa below 3.0 may apply by special petition
- Two letters of recommendation
- 500-word essay outlining intellectual and academic interests, accomplishments, and career objectives
- Current resume
- Initial or Professional New York State Certificate in Teaching or qualify for Initial Certification within three semester
- Participation in an interview
- If educated in a country other than the U.S. review
