Post-Master's Certificate in Nursing-Family Nurse Practitioner

The Post-Master's Certificate in Family Nurse Practitioner program is accredited by the commission on collegiate Nursing Education (<http://www.ccneaccreditation.org>). The Post-Master's Certificate program follows a Cohort Model, allowing students to attend classes on campus for just one day a week to ensure successful completion. With a variety of clients in community and health settings, the program prepares nurses for advanced practice. The graduates of this program are qualified for NYS license as a nurse practitioner and eligible to take the national certification exam for FNP.

Admissions Requirements

- Official transcripts for all post-secondary institutions attended
- Master's degree in Nursing or foreign equivalent from an accredited school
- Minimum undergraduate and graduate school gpa of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation: A) one from a former instructor or academic adviser, B) one from a recent employer or supervisor
- 500-word essay outlining goals, career goals, intellectual and academic interests, and accomplishments that support a Post-Master's Nursing Certificate
- Current professional resume
- Interview with members of the graduate admissions committee
- Unencumbered registered nurse license, and current registration in NYS
- At least one year working experience as a registered nurse
- Conference with adviser in the graduate nursing program before starting the program. (During their first semester, students are required to plan their program with an advisor. All students must complete the 30-credit curriculum with a cumulative index of 3.0 or better)
