# Federal and State Programs

The New York State COVID-19 Pandemic Small Business Recovery Grant Program provides grants to New York small businesses, micro-businesses and for-profit independent arts and cultural organizations.

The **New York Forward Loan Fund** offers low-interest loans to NY businesses with 50 or fewer employees

#### **Child Care Stabilization Grant**

For clients that have not already submitted an application in response to outreach from the Office of Child and Family Services. Read more! Deadline is Tue. Nov 30

For restaurants, the state offers Restaurant Resiliency Program grants for restaurants that choose to provide meals and food to people within distressed or underrepresented communities.

There is also a **Restaurant Return-to-Work Tax Credit** to help bring restaurant staff back-to-work, and to increase hiring at NYS restaurants.

# Legal resources for small businesses

There are a range of resources available to New York City small businesses:

**SBA loans**: many lenders are re-energizing traditional loan programs, including microloans, 7A (typical business loans) and 504 loans (for property and equipment).

**Brooklyn Alliance Capital** is offering grants for purchase of PPE and zero-interest **Bring Back Brooklyn Loans** of up to \$10,000.

#### WomensNet Amber Grant

WomensNet gives away at least \$10,000 every month in Amber Grant money. They've now added an Annual \$25,000 Amber Grant as well as marketing and \$2000 mini grants. **See the full list here**.

#### Crowdfunding

Rewards crowdfunding sites such as **Kickstarter**, **Indiegogo** or **iFundWomen** can help provide funding to launch or grow products or services.

Debt crowdfunding, such as **Kiva** or **Mainvest** can provide crowdsourced debt for many businesses.

#### **NY State and City Programs**

New York's <u>Shared Work Program</u> lets companies keep trained staff and avoid layoffs. Employees can receive partial Unemployment Insurance benefits while working reduced hours. Full-time, part-time and seasonal employees are eligible.
