#### South Bronx Businesses:

A new \$10 million loan program for Bronx businesses, funded with money left over from the long-forgotten Bronx empowerment zone, was announced on 8/17/2023 by U.S. Rep. Ritchie Torres (D-The Bronx) and Bronx Borough President Vanessa Gibson. The loans, to be handed out by the Bronx Economic Development Corporation, will range from \$5,000 to \$350,000 and can be used for a variety of purposes including payroll, inventory and equipment. Eligible businesses will be primarily in the South Bronx, which was the heart of the federal empowerment zone. **Click here for more**.

The funding will be provided through the federal Small Business Administration's (SBA) Community Advantage Loan Program.
