On October 10, 2023, Provost Jorge Silva-Puras, joined by Commissioner Kevin D. Kim and Deputy Commissioner Yurij Pawluk of NYC Department of Small Business Services, as well as SCPS Dean Jane MacKillop, celebrated the extraordinary achievements of Lehman's Immigrant Nursing Program graduates. The 24 nurses in the program's second cohort represent 20 countries and completed 8 months of intensive ESOL/board exam training: they are now on track to join the NYC healthcare workforce as New York State Registered Nurses. A common theme expressed by the graduates was their desire to give back to the community that provided them with this life-changing opportunity. Cohort 3 is tentatively scheduled to start this SBS-sponsored, no-cost training on March 28, 2024: learn more about the Immigrant Nursing Program here.

ESD Programs Offer Unprecedented Access to Capital for Loans, Equity and Technical Assistance for Small Businesses.
More than \$500 million in federal funding is now available to support the resurgence of small businesses across New York State through the State Small Business Credit Initiative (SSBCI), a program through the American Rescue Plan Act. Managed by the U.S. Department of Treasury, SSBCI provides funds to support programs for small businesses, including socially and economically disadvantaged individual (SEDI) owned businesses and very small businesses (VSB). New \$10 Million Loan Program Aimed at South Bronx Businesses:

A new \$10 million loan program for Bronx businesses, funded with money left over from the long-forgotten Bronx empowerment zone, was announced on 8/17/2023 by U.S. Rep. Ritchie Torres (D-The Bronx) and Bronx Borough President Vanessa Gibson.
The loans, to be handed out by the Bronx Economic Development Corporation, will range from \$5,000 to \$350,000 and can be used for a variety of purposes including payroll, inventory and equipment. Eligible businesses will be primarily in the South Bronx, which was the heart of the federal empowerment zone.
